Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0001 UTC to 2359 UTC

#### General Situation

Low sea area Wight will move slowly southwards during Sunday. A ridge of high pressure will persist across central and northern parts of the United Kingdom.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 in south at first, and occasionally 6 in northwest later.

Occasional rain then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate in south, moderate or rough in north.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 5 or 6 occasionally 7 for a time in south.

Rain.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south at first.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5.

Rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rough.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 6 or 7 in far north at first, otherwise easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, backing northeasterly 5 or 6 later.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rough, decreasing slight or moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 or 5 becoming northeasterly 5 or 6.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in east at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Moderate or rough, decreasing slight near coast.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 6 to gale 8 decreasing 5 or 6.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Moderate or rough, decreasing slight near coast.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 6 to gale 8 decreasing 5 or 6 later.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in south at first.

Mainly fair then occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south at first.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south at first.

Occasional rain in south otherwise mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Slight, occasionally moderate in south at first.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Slight or moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Mainly northerly in southeast, otherwise variable 3 or 4.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4.

Fair.

Good.

Smooth or slight.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4.

Occasional rain in north, mainly fair in south.

Moderate or good.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate, increasing rough in north and far west.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Moderate or rough.

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
