Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
England, Wales and Northern Ireland will be largely sunny but very cold with frost persisting all day in some areas. Scotland will be cloudier with outbreaks of rain and hill snow at times, these spreading south into northern England and Northern Ireland later. Many places dry overnight but becoming cloudy, some snow flurries possible. Another hard frost in the south.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Cold again on Wednesday with a little sleet in places, although some eastern areas should have some sunshine at times. Thursday will be cold again in the south, but dry in most parts with variable cloud and patches of fog.
