Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Some rain at first, especially across northern and western England and Wales. However, this should soon move away with many places then having a dry day. There will still be a good deal of cloud around but some bright or sunny spells will occur, the best of these likely across Northern Ireland and northwest Scotland.

Dry and rather cloudy in most places tonight. Some clearer skies are expected across Northern Ireland and southern Scotland, leading to local frost and fog patches.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Staying generally dry on both Thursday and Friday. Still rather cloudy but some sunshine likely, especially in central parts.
