Forecast for Thursday 09 Dec 2021

Weather: Mainly dry with some clear spells developing overnight, snow showers in the north dying out. Mainly dry and bright during daylight hours, perhaps the odd snow showers around Ben Lawers and the west. However, snow and low level rain pushing in from the west around dusk. Rain mainly below 600m.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 70% for much of daylight hours falling 20% or less from dusk.

Visibility: Mainly good or very good during daylight hours, occasionally poor in any snow. Becoming poor or very poor at height from dusk. Occasional or patchy cloud, base 600 to 900m lifting and clearing for a time around midday. Cloud becoming extensive, base 600m, from dusk.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Forecast for Friday 10 Dec 2021

Weather: Bright spells with snow showers, the best of the brightness over the Aberdeenshire and Angus hills with the snow showers most frequent around Ben Lawers. Most of the snow showers dying out in the evening with clear spells. Showers mainly of rain below 600m.

Maximum wind: West or Northwest 20 to 25 gusts 35mph with a significant wind chill.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 70%

Visibility: Mainly very good or excellent, but poor or very poor in snow showers. Occasional or extensive cloud, mainly around the summits, but lower in showers.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 1 Celsius rising to 6 Celsius
At 800m: Minus 2 Celsius
Freezing level: Around 600m
