



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Atlantic fronts will cross from the southwest on Sunday evening, followed by a strong showery southwesterly airstream overnight, with troughs enhancing these showers at times. A further 15-25 mm is expected quite widely within the warning area, with perhaps 30-40 mm over the hills. With the ground still saturated after the recent wet weather, these amounts of rain will be enough to cause some low impact surface water flooding.

This warning has been updated to focus on the wettest areas tonight, and to slightly extend the period into Monday morning.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **17:00 on Sun, 07th Feb 2016** until **08:00 on Mon, 08th Feb 2016**

Showers or longer spells of rain will continue to affect southern Scotland on Sunday evening, and overnight into Monday morning. Please be aware of some difficult driving conditions due to standing water and spray, and some localised surface water flooding.
