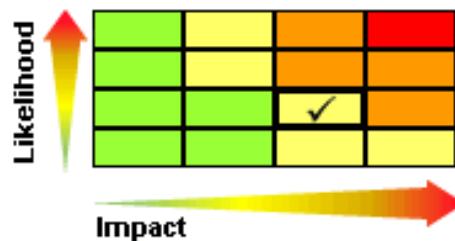
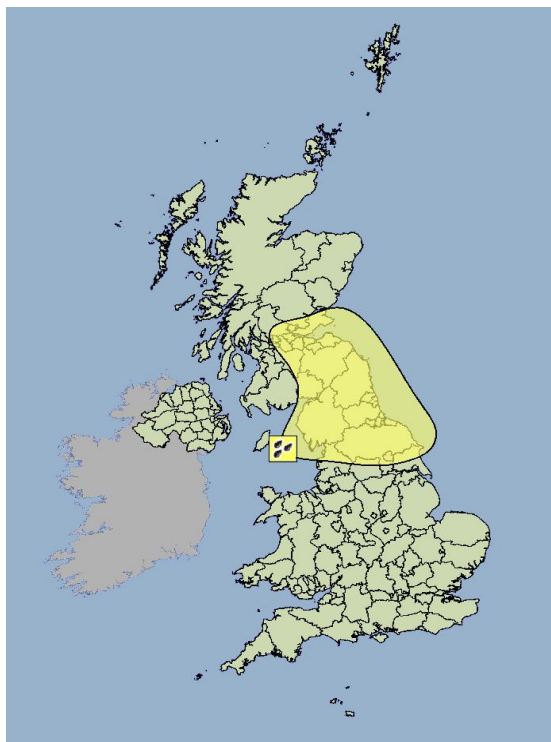


National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Showers are expected to develop early Saturday afternoon over North Wales and the Midlands and then track north or northeastwards during the rest of the day into the evening. Whilst many will miss the worst of the showers some places could see 30 mm of rain in an hour or less along with frequent lightning and hail. There is also the potential for some locally strong winds in association with these.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **16:25 on Sat, 27th May 2017** until **23:00 on Sat, 27th May 2017**

Heavy, thundery showers on Saturday afternoon and evening have the potential to bring torrential rain, hail and frequent lightning.

Be aware of the risk of localised flooding with longer journey times possible as well as some interruption to utilities and services.

This is an update to trim the southern extent of the warning area, removing this from the Midlands & Wales as the main area has now moved northwards.
