Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Sunday 02 November to 1200 UTC Monday 03 November 2014

General Situation

A strong locally gale force southwesterly airflow is currently affecting the British Isles bringing showers or longer spells of rain to many areas. A developing area of low pressure out in the Atlantic will move eastwards across Northern Ireland during Monday before filling over great Britain during Tuesday morning.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7 backing south 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming cyclonic 4 or 5, then north or northeast 6 to gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate becoming rough or very rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4, then north 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5 becoming variable mainly northwest 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.
Showers.
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 6 to gale 8 decreasing 4 or 5, then increasing 6 to gale 8 again later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7 decreasing 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally 5 at first, increasing severe gale 9 at times later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 6 to gale 8 decreasing 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Rough becoming moderate, then slight later.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 or 6 decreasing 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5 increasing 6 to gale 8, then decreasing 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough near the Isles of Scilly.

Rain or squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 to 7 veering northwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times later.

Very rough at first near the Isles of Scilly, otherwise moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5 increasing 6 to gale 8, then decreasing 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest veering northwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest veering northwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, then decreasing 4 for a time.

Moderate, occasionally rough in south.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate in south, moderate or rough in north.

Rain or squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic then northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in northwest.

Moderate or rough at first in north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7 veering west 3 or 4, then north 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time, then becoming cyclonic 4 later in north.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Showers, squally at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic becoming northwest 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first, then veering north 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North

Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 4 at times later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in North Channel.
Showers, squally at first.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South becoming cyclonic then north, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in North Channel.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7 backing south 4 or 5, then backing southeast 3 or 4 later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough near Tiree.
Showers, squally at first.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 backing north 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, but increasing 6 or 7 later near Coll and Tiree.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough near Tiree.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 or 7 decreasing 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Moderate or rough at first except just north of skye, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers, squally at first.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 becoming north 4 or 5, then increasing 6 to gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough, then very rough later in north.
Showers, squally later.
Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 or 7 decreasing 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Moderate or rough.
Showers, squally at first.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 becoming north 4 or 5, then increasing 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 later.
Moderate or rough becoming rough or very rough.
Showers, squally later.
Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 02 Nov 2014 at 1200 UTC until Monday 03 Nov 2014 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A fresh to strong southwesterly flow over Shetland waters eases during Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southwesterly gale force 8 at time of issue.

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in the north.
Rough.
Isolated showers.
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 03 Nov until 1200 UTC on Monday 03 Nov:
Southwesterly 5 or 6, backing southerly 4.
Moderate or rough.
Isolated showers.
Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 4 to 5, locally 6, increasing 5 to 6 by evening, further increasing 6 to 7 overnight, locally gale 8 for a time, decreasing 4 to 5 tomorrow afternoon.

Rather rough to rough, locally moderate in the south this afternoon.

Scattered showers, becoming frequent and heavy at times overnight and tomorrow morning risk of thunder.

Good, locally moderate to poor showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest to west 5 to 6, soon decreasing 4 to 5, further decreasing 3 to 4 for a time overnight, veering northwest in the morning.

Moderate to rather rough, becoming slight to moderate, with a swell.

Scattered showers, heavy at times with a risk of thunder.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.
