Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West 3 to 4, perhaps locally 5 mid-channel, becoming northwest 2 to 3 near the
brittany coast this afternoon, generally decreasing 1 to 3 around midnight,
becoming variable by dawn.
Slight, locally smooth on Tuesday.
Patchy light drizzle and mist, mainly in the far north this afternoon and
overnight.
Good, locally moderate to poor in drizzle.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming northeast 3 to 4 by late afternoon, perhaps locally 5
in the south, veering east overnight.
Smooth or slight.
Risk of mist and fog patches forming overnight.
Good, perhaps becoming locally poor or very poor overnight.
