Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0001 UTC to 2359 UTC

General Situation

High pressure builds over northern Scotland, then moves away slowly northeast. Pressure remains low to the south of the United Kingdom.

From Cape Wrath to Ratray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4 veering southeast 4 or 5.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Slight or moderate.

Ratray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly east or northeast 3 or 4.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south at first.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 or 5 decreasing 3 or 4.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south later.

Occasional drizzle, fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east later.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 5 or 6 decreasing 4 or 5.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far west at first.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west at first.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in southwest at first.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeast 5 or 6 veering east or southeast 3 or 4.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway  
24 hour forecast:  
East or northeast 4 or 5.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in southwest.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeasterly veering easterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north at first.  
Occasional rain or drizzle later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.  
Slight.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough  
24 hour forecast:  
Northerly veering easterly or southeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Mainly slight.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near headlands.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Smooth or slight.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point  
24 hour forecast:  
Mainly easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west.  
Occasional drizzle.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Slight.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeasterly veering southerly, 4 or 5, perhaps occasionally 6 in far west later.  
Occasional drizzle.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:  
Northerly veering southerly, 3 or 4.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.  
Moderate or rough decreasing slight or moderate.
