General Situation

A large area of high pressure across much of the United Kingdom will bring settled weather to most areas. However, windy conditions are expected through the English Channel and at times in the far north, where drizzle and fog patches are likely at times.

General Situation

High pressure will be slow moving over UK and North Sea, while low over Denmark Strait will move east or northeast towards Norwegian Sea during Thursday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

West 5 or 6, backing southwest 5 to 7.

Moderate, becoming rough later in northwest.

Occasional rain or drizzle and fog patches.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Thursday 01 Oct until 0600 UTC on Friday 02 Oct:
