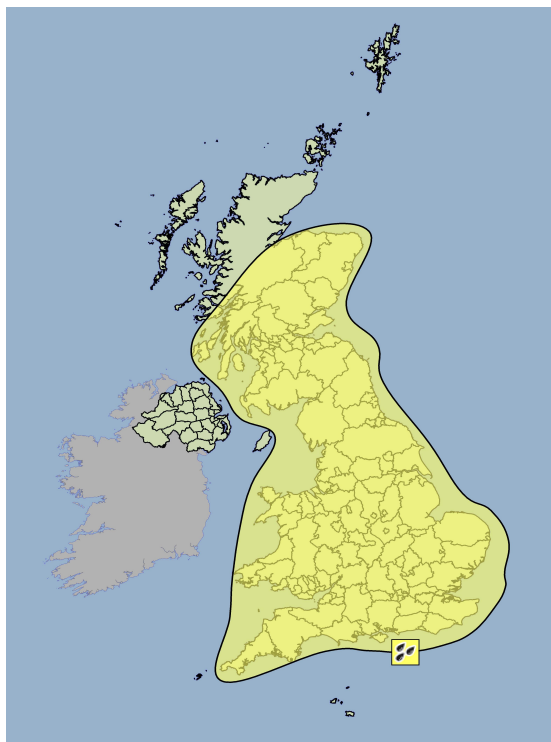




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

Following a build of very warm and humid air there is the potential for the development of intense thunderstorms over the UK from Friday night. In this situation large amounts of energy are available in the atmosphere and this coupled with high moisture content can lead to torrential downpours along with frequent lightning activity, large hail and locally strong gusts. In this situation many elements need to come together at the same time to form these thunderstorms and so there remains large uncertainty in their development.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **00:05 on Sat, 19th Jul 2014** until **23:55 on Sat, 19th Jul 2014**

Areas of heavy, thundery showers will develop over England and Wales from Friday night before moving northwards into Scotland during Saturday. The location of these is uncertain but where they do form some torrential downpours are possible with frequent lightning, large hail and locally strong gusts. Significant flooding is possible where these do occur from surface water as well as from small, fast responding watercourses. The frequent lightning, large hail and strong gusts could also be an additional hazard.

The public should be aware of the risk of disruption from any of these elements. This warning has been updated to extend the area at risk further northwest across Scotland.
