Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Friday 01 September to 1800 UTC Saturday 02 September 2023

General Situation

Shallow lows over England and celtic sea will fill, as a high will move south over the British Isles on Saturday. A band of rain and drizzle will affect northern Scotland later on Saturday and into Sunday, bringing strong southwesterly winds there.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4, veering south 2 to 4, then southwest 3 to 5, occasionally 6 near Cape Wrath.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in northwest.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 to 5, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7 near Cape Wrath.

Slight or moderate, but smooth at first in southeast, becoming rough or very rough later in northwest.

Showers, then rain or drizzle mainly in north.

Smooth, occasionally slight near Mull of Galloway.

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Easterly or northeasterly 2 to 4, veering southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in sheltered southeast.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5, increasing 6 in northwest.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough, but slight or moderate in sheltered southeast.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North or northeast, becoming variable, 2 to 4, then southwest 5 or 6.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in south, becoming slight or moderate later.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure covers Shetland Waters but will move away east on Saturday as fronts approach from the Atlantic.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

North or northeast becoming variable, 2 to 4
Mainly slight, but smooth just east of Shetland
Mainly fair

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Saturday 02 Sep until 1800 UTC on Saturday 02 Sep:

Variable 2 to 4 becoming south or southwest 4 or 5
Slight, becoming moderate in north and west

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 to 3, becoming northeast 2 to 4 by dawn.
Smooth or slight with a low swell.
Risk of showers.
Good, perhaps occasionally moderate.

Northeasterly 2 to 4, occasionally 5 in the afternoon.
Smooth or slight with a low swell.
Risk of mist until Sunday morning.
Good, perhaps occasionally poor until Sunday morning.

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
