**Meteorologist's View**

**Forecast for Thursday 11 Nov 2021**

**Weather:** Similar to Wednesday with bright spells and many avoiding the few light showers, but outbreaks tending to build through the afternoon, chiefly in the west, before dying away through the evening.

**Maximum wind:** Variable 15mph or less, becoming southeast 15-20mph by early evening with gusts reaching 35mph across most exposed ridges and summits.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** 90% becoming 80% during the afternoon

**Visibility:** Generally good or very good, becoming moderate in showers and very poor in hill fog with bases infrequently lowering 500m as showers push through, chiefly during the afternoon.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Plus 3 Celsius increasing 13 Celsius during the afternoon  
**At 800m:** Plus 4  
**Freezing level:** Above all summits
