### Forecast for Friday 02 Dec 2022

**Weather:** A dry night but some mist and fog conditions further east towards Crickhowell. A bright start for most but mist and fog may be persistent inland for a few hours in the morning. Sunny spells are likely for much of the day but feeling cold in the easterly winds.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m:** 80% improving to 90%. Low cloud further east where fog forms.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Moderate or poor visibility expected in the morning further east in mist, otherwise good visibility is likely with good views possible. Scattered or broken cloud above 500m further east otherwise very little low cloud expected,

**Meteorologist's View**

Light winds, turning fresher later, starting to feel quite cold later in the day as cooler air spreads across from the east.

**Recent rainfall:** measured at Neuadd: altitude 353m

**Forecast for Saturday 03 Dec 2022**

**Weather:** Clear spells overnight with some mist and fog forming, leading into a dry and bright day with sunnier intervals possible, however cloud may be slow to clear in places. Feeling cold in the keen easterly winds.

**Maximum wind:** Northeasterly 15-20 gusts 25-30mph.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m:** 70%, perhaps some patches of lower cloud around eastern mountains.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Visibility will generally be good with views across the area but further east will be poor to start in any mist and fog. Some scattered cloud above 500m in the east but otherwise cloud well above the summits.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Minus 1 rising to 6 Celsius.  
**At 600m:** Zero Celsius  
**Freezing level:** 800m
