General Situation

A trough of low pressure lying across the United Kingdom will be replaced by the ridge building from the southwest during Monday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

North 3 or 4, backing south or southwest later.

Slight but moderate in north.

Occasional rain, then showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4, veering southwest 4 or 5.

Slight but moderate in north.

Showers, then occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

North 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in east.

Occasional rain, then showers.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

Westerly or southwesterly, veering northerly or northwesterly later, 3 or 4.
Slight.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, backing southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

North backing west 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate west of the Lizard peninsula otherwise slight.

Fair then occasional rain.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

North or northwest, 3 or 4.

Slight but moderate in far southwest.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 3 or 4, backing west 4 or 5.

Slight but moderate in far southwest.

Fair then occasional rain.
Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less, becoming northwest 3 or 4 for a time.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less, becoming southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Smooth or slight.
Fair then occasional rain.
Moderate or good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Northwest 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5.
Mainly slight.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest backing southwest, 4 or 5.
Mainly slight.
Fair, then occasional rain for a time.
Good, occasionally moderate for a time.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
West or northwest 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5 for a time.
Slight.

West or northwest, backing southwest for a time, 3 or 4.

Southwest veering west, 3 or 4 increasing 5 at times.
Slight, occasionally moderate in north.
Occasional rain, then showers.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

Northwest 4 or 5, backing southwest 3 or 4 later.

Moderate.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later.

Southwest veering west, 3 or 4 increasing 4 or 5.

Moderate, becoming rough in north and west later.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure topples across Shetland waters over the next 24 hours.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

North backing northwest 3 or 4.

Mainly moderate, but slight in well sheltered southern and eastern waters.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 02 Aug until 1800 UTC on Monday 02

Aug:

Northwest backing west or southwest 3 or 4.

Mainly moderate in northern and western waters, mainly slight in southern and eastern waters.

Showers dying out.

Mainly good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 3 to 4, decreasing 2 to 3 this evening, veering north 3 to 4 in the morning, backing northwest by evening.

Slight.

Occasional rain clearing Monday morning to become fair or fine.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 2 to 4 backing west to southwest 3 to 4 on Tuesday.

Slight.

Fair becoming cloud on Tuesday perhaps with some rain or drizzle in the afternoon.

Good becoming locally moderate later.

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
