General Situation

A complex and shallow area of low pressure will move slowly southeastwards across the southern half of the United Kingdom during the rest of today, before losing its identity over northern France during Friday. High pressure will then build across the United Kingdom during the rest of the period.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Variable becoming mainly northerly or northeasterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6
for a time in far north.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain or showers, fog patches, becoming mainly fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East or northeast 3 or 4, veering southeast 4 or 5 later.
Slight.
Showers then fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

Northeasterly 3 or 4 at first in south, otherwise easterly or northeasterly 5 to
7, veering southeast 4 or 5 later.

Occasional rain or showers, becoming fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

General Situation

High pressure over Iceland moving towards Faeroes will continue to amplify a ridge southeast over Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Northeast 4 or 5.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first in north.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Friday 02 May until 1200 UTC on Friday 02 May:

Northeast 4 or 5 backing north 3.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West veering northwest 4 occasionally 5, veering northwest to north 4 this evening then northerly 3 or 4 tomorrow.

Slight to moderate.

Rain or drizzle in east at first, then risk of showers especially late period.

Locally moderate in east at first otherwise mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 3 to 4, veering easterly overnight.

Slight with a low swell.

Fair.
