Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Saturday 02 July to 0000 UTC Sunday 03 July 2016

General Situation

A large area of low pressure to the north of Scotland will move slowly northeastwards to lie over the Norwegian Sea by Sunday. This will bring a cool and showery westerly air flow to the whole country before a frontal system moves across southern England on Sunday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

Variable 3 or 4, becoming west or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate in northwest, smooth or slight in southeast.

Thundery showers.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times in south, then becoming variable 3 or less later in north.

West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 or 6.

West or southwest becoming variable for a time later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at times, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later in north.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fair.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7.

Moderate, occasionally slight.

Showers, thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, then becoming variable for a time later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7.

Moderate, occasionally slight.

Showers, thundery for a time.

Good, occasionally poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, then becoming cyclonic for a time.

Moderate becoming slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle, becoming fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough west of Lizard.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West becoming cyclonic for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Moderate west of Lizard, otherwise slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, backing southwest 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, becoming cyclonic for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate, but rough at first near St Davids Head.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in south.

Occasional rain or drizzle later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less later in north.

Slight.

Showers.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers for a time.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or westerly 5 or 6, increasing 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time near Mull of Kintyre.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing mainly 3 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times in south.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in far south.

Thundery showers.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times in south.

Moderate or rough.

West or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A shallow depression centred near the Faeroes will drift northeast into the Norwegian Sea on Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

West or southwest 2 or 3 occasionally 4 later.

Moderate but slight just east of Shetland.

Isolated showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Saturday 02 Jul until 0000 UTC on Sunday 03 Jul:

West or southwest 3 or 4.

Moderate but slight just east of Shetland.

Isolated showers.

Mainly good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 5 to 6, decreasing 4 to 5 by Saturday evening.

Moderate to rather rough.

Isolated showers, dying out in the afternoon.

Good, occasionally moderate in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to southwest 4 to 5, backing southwest to south by dawn, occasionally 6 in the morning, veering west by midday, further veering northwest for a time in the afternoon.

Moderate to rather rough, with a low swell.

Occasional rain and drizzle spreading in from the west, with mist and a risk of fog patches, perhaps clearing for a time later.

Good, becoming moderate by early morning, occasionally poor or very poor perhaps locally good for a time later.

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
