Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

#### General Situation

A large ridge of high pressure will continue to extend south across the United Kingdom during the next few days. Meanwhile, a weak cold front will move southwards across England and Wales.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east.

Slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5, especially in north.

Variable 3 becoming onshore, then easterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Onshore 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
