Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0600 UTC Thursday 01 June to 0600 UTC Friday 02 June 2017

General Situation

A declining ridge of high pressure will slowly move away eastwards, but conditions will remain settled in the south and east today. Meanwhile, Atlantic fronts will edge into northern and western areas, bringing spells of rain here.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, veering south 3 or 4, then becoming variable 3 or less later. Slight in Moray Firth, otherwise slight or moderate. Fair, then occasional rain or showers. Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Rain then showers, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first near Rattray Head.

Rain at times later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight.

Occasional rain, then showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable, mainly south, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Rain later in north.

Good, occasionally moderate later in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less.

Slight.

Rain or showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South, becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Rain or showers for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time in north.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly, becoming variable, 2 or 3, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming mainly easterly or southeasterly, 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming westerly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, becoming variable at times, 2 or 3, increasing 4 at times later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming west or southwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

In west, southerly or southwesterly, veering northwesterly later, 3 or 4, elsewhere, variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in west, becoming rough later near the Isles of Scilly.

Fog patches, rain later in west.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 at first in east, otherwise westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later near the Isles of Scilly.

Smooth or slight in lyme bay, otherwise slight or moderate, but occasionally rough near the Isles of Scilly.

Fog patches and rain at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in west, becoming variable 3 or less at times in the Bristol Channel.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in west, becoming rough later in southwest.

Fog patches, rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South, veering west or northwest, then backing southwest later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Slight or moderate, but rough at first in southwest.
Occasional rain and fog patches at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north.
Slight or moderate.
Rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest, becoming variable for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times later.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near St Davids Head.
Rain at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north and west, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in west.
Rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4, becoming southwest 4 or 5 later.
Smooth or slight.
Rain at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain later.
Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times later.
Smooth or slight.
Rain at first.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain, becoming fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South, becoming variable for a time, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Fair, then showers.
Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.

Moderate, becoming slight.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly, becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair, then showers.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then veering southwest 2 or 3 later.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 or 6, veering southwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then showers.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 or 6, veering southwest 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times later.

Moderate or rough.

Fair then showers.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Thursday 01 Jun 2017 at 0600 UTC until Thursday 01 Jun 2017 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

The ridge of high pressure across Shetland will be replaced by a strengthening southeasterly airflow during Thursday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Variable 2 or 3, becoming southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times later in the south and west.
Slight or moderate.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Thursday 01 Jun until 0600 UTC on Friday 02 Jun:
Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in the south and west.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or variable 1 to 3, locally 4, becoming west by Friday morning.
Smooth or slight.
Mist or fog patches.
Moderate to good, locally poor or very poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 2 to 3, locally 4, increasing 3 to 4 by evening, veering northwest overnight.
Slight, locally moderate with a swell.
Mist or fog patches a little rain in the afternoon, clearing by evening.
Moderate to good, occasionally poor or very poor.

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
