Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0000 UTC to 0000 UTC

General Situation

Pressure will remain high to the west of the United Kingdom, linking to a developing area of high pressure over Scandinavia by Thursday with pressure falling to the south of the British Isles.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southeasterly in east, 2 or 3, increasing 4 at times, becoming northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, slight in Moray Firth.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, veering northeast 5 or 6.

Moderate, slight in Moray Firth.

Occasional rain or drizzle then showers.

Moderate, occasionally poor becoming good.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, becoming moderate in north.

Occasional rain or drizzle then showers.

Moderate, occasionally poor becoming good.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest, veering east or southeast later, 2 or 3, increasing 4 at times.

Slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast becoming variable 3 or less, then north or northeast, 4 or 5.

Mainly slight.

Occasional rain, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Westerly becoming variable, 2 or 3.

Slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming southeast 2 or 3, backing northeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Occasional rain, becoming mainly fair.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

In north, westerly veering easterly or northeasterly 2 or 3, occasionally 4 later, in south, northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.

Mainly slight.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, decreasing 2 or 3.

Smooth or slight in east, moderate in west.

Fair then occasional rain.

North or northwest 2 or 3, veering northeast 3 or 4.  
Moderate in west at first, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 or 4.

Slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest veering north or northeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around St Davids Head.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Westerly or northwesterly veering northerly or northeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west later.

West or northwest 4 or 5.

Smooth with shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest veering north, 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Occasional rain then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

West 3 or 4, veering north later, 4 or 5.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A shallow depression will move southeast close to Shetland on Wednesday. A ridge of high pressure will then build over the Norwegian Sea.

Slight or moderate.

Rain later in the northwest.

Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Wednesday 05 May until 0000 UTC on Thursday 06 May:

Southwest veering northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time in the north.
