Forecast for Thursday 10 Feb 2022

Weather: Clear or sunny spells through much of the day with just a few sleet or snow showers around. However cloud is expected to increase from mid-afternoon bringing an increased risk of sleet or snow showers for a time in the early evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: Close to 90% through much of the day but falling to 60% from mid-afternoon until mid-evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Only small amounts of cloud generally below the summits but becoming occasional or periods above 600m for a time from mid-afternoon. Otherwise visibility very good or excellent falling to several kilometres in sleet showers and perhaps a kilometre in snow showers.

Gusts around 40mph over higher ridges and summits around the middle of the day.

Forecast for Friday 11 Feb 2022

Weather: A dry day with clear or sunny spells, the sunshine rather hazy at times, especially later in the day, as cloud above the summits increases.

Maximum wind: Westerly backing southerly or southwesterly around 10mph, increasing 15-20mph through the late evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: Around 90%.

Low cloud and visibility: Only small amounts of cloud expected below the summits. Otherwise visibility very good.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Around minus 2 or 3 Celsius at dawn rising to plus 8 or 9 Celsius in the afternoon.
At 600m: Around minus 2 Celsius, rising to plus 1 Celsius later
Freezing level: Around 400m rising to 750m in the evening
