Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Drier and brighter for many today, with sunny spells and isolated showers.
Turning cloudy in the west, with a band of rain arriving later. Rain will
continue eastwards overnight, clearing western counties to leave occasional
showers, heavy and wintry at times in the southwest by dawn.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain will linger across northern and eastern Britain for much of Saturday.
Elsewhere, a mixture of sunshine and showers, these wintry over higher ground.
The rain will slowly clear Scotland on Sunday and most other places will be dry
and bright, but rain and strengthening winds will spread across south-western
Britain.
