



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment
 Heavy showers are expected to develop early in the day and will likely turn thundery and locally intense. Whilst most places will miss the worst, 20 mm of rain in an hour is likely in places, with a low risk of more than 30 mm locally. Lightning could be an additional hazard.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **10:00 on Mon, 10th Jul 2017** until **18:00 on Mon, 10th Jul 2017**

Heavy, thundery showers could lead to localised flooding, especially where they affect urban areas.
