Forecast for Wednesday 09 Jun 2021

Weather: Mainly dry overnight but patchy light rain arriving around dawn. A cloudy and misty day with outbreaks of rain or drizzle. Some brief brightness possible towards Blencathra and hills around Ullswater.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 30% in morning 5% in afternoon as cloud bases lower.

Visibility: Very poor visibility at height for most of the day. Patchy cloud on the summits at first becoming extensive down to 300 or 400m, perhaps lifting to higher slopes in the east. Below the cloud case, hazy, often poor in rain or drizzle, perhaps good at times in the east.

Meteorologist's View

A damp and humid southerly airstream will affect the Lake District with extensive poor visibility so good navigation skills will be required. Gales possible on the highest summits above 900m.

Forecast for Thursday 10 Jun 2021

Weather: Mostly cloudy with patchy light rain or drizzle. A little brightness possible at times over northeastern fells. Warm and humid.

Maximum wind: South or SW 25-30mph with gusts 40mph, perhaps 50mph above 900m.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: Mainly 10%, but 30% in northeast.

Visibility: Extensive cloud above 300 or 400m in the morning, lifting to 600 or 700m in the afternoon and breaking up across northeastern fells. Generally good below the cloud, briefly poor in drizzly outbreaks.

Temperature: **Valleys:** 13C rising to 19 or 20C.
At 800m: 11 to 13C.
Freezing level: Well above summits.
