

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 08 Mar 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cold and blustery, with a mix of sunshine and occasional heavy wintry showers.  
The showers falling as either rain, sleet, hail or snow. Westerly winds will  
reach gale force at times, especially in the west. Remaining rather windy  
tonight, with further wintry showers in places. Icy patches also likely in  
places tonight, especially on higher ground.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Partly sunny and windy on Monday with scattered showers, falling as sleet or  
hail in the north at times. Sunniest across southeast Scotland and southeast  
England on Monday. Wet weather will spread eastwards Monday night. Bright and  
breezy on Tuesday with scattered light showers.
