Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Sunday 02 November to 0600 UTC Monday 03 November 2014

#### General Situation

A strong, locally gale force, southwesterly airflow covers the United Kingdom on Sunday. An Atlantic low moving steadily eastwards will be centred over Northern Ireland by midday Monday. This low is then expected to slowly fill, and move to northern England by Tuesday morning.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, backing south 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South, becoming cyclonic, 4 or 5, then becoming northeast later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Showers, rain at times.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, backing south 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in north.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain at times.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers, rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in south, decreasing 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 6 to gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or squally showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5.

Rough becoming moderate, occasionally slight later.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5, then veering west later.

Rough becoming moderate.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 5 or 6, backing southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate in lyme bay.

Occasional rain or squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, veering west or northwest 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate in lyme bay.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4 or 5, backing southwest 5 to 7, perhaps increasing gale 8 for a time later.

Rough.

Squally showers, rain for a time later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, veering northwest 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West 4 or 5, backing southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Squally showers, rain for a time later.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 5 to 7, veering northwest 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate, occasionally rough in south.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
West, backing southwest, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.  
Moderate, occasionally rough at first.  
Squally showers, rain for a time later.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 for a time, then veering west later.  
Moderate.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest 5 or 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 5 or 6, veering west or northwest 4 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, backing south 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.  
Showers, squally at first.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6, then becoming north or northwest later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.  
Thundery showers, rain at first.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, backing southerly 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in the North Channel.  
Showers, squally at first.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6, then becoming northerly or northwesterly later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in the North Channel.

Thundery showers, rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, backing southeast 4 or 5 later. Rough.

Occasional rain or squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 4 or 5, backing north or northeast 5 or 6.

Rough, occasionally moderate later.

Showers, rain for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, backing southeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight later.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, backing northerly or northeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later in north.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, squally later.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, backing southeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Rough.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, backing northerly or northeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later in north.

Rough, occasionally very rough later.

Showers, squally later.

Good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A large depression will remain south of Iceland, with a frontal trough moving northeast across Shetland early on Sunday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Gale force 8 veering southwesterly imminent, issued at 0349GMT on 2nd November.

Cyclonic becoming southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north.

Rough, occasionally very rough at first.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 02 Nov until 0600 UTC on Monday 03 Nov:  
Southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 4 later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:

South to southwest 6 to 7, locally gale 8, veering southwest to west late morning and decreasing 4 to 6, locally 7 in the north late evening.  
Rather rough to rough, decreasing early afternoon, moderate in the south to rather rough in the north.  
Rain, locally heavy, then scattered showers in the afternoon and evening.  
Good, locally moderate to poor in rain or showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West to southwest 5 to 6, decreasing 3 to 4 in the afternoon, but gusty near showers.  
Moderate to rough, becoming slight to moderate in the afternoon with a swell.  
Rain or scattered showers, heavy at times.  
Good, locally moderate to poor in rain or showers.

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
