Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It should be another dry day for many, but with a cold and frosty start. Cloud is expected to thicken during the day across northeastern coasts and parts of southeast England in particular. It may even be thick enough for the odd spot of drizzle. Winds should be mostly light, although breezier around southern coasts, and it will feel chilly.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Remaining rather cold, but dry with bright spells across Northern Ireland and Scotland. Cloudier across England and Wales though, with outbreaks of rain at times. Winds should stay light for many, but continue rather breezy for southern parts of England.
