General Situation

Low pressure over the near Continent will continue to bring strong winds, rain and showers for the south and east of the United Kingdom today. For the north and west, high pressure will continue to bring largely fine and settled conditions.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly veering northeasterly later, 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later in southeast.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches developing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, fog patches at first.
