General Situation

An unseasonably cold northeasterly flow will be maintained between high pressure to the northwest of the United Kingdom and low pressure over the near Continent. The wind will always remain strongest across the south.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A ridge of high pressure extending south across Shetland waters will decline during Thursday night, as a shallow depression tracks east across the Faeroes.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Northeast 3 or 4, easing 2 or 3 in the northwest of the area.
Slight or moderate.
Isolated showers.
Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Friday 05 Apr until 1200 UTC on Friday 05 Apr:

Northeast 3 or 4, becoming locally variable 2 or 3 for a time in the west, then backing west or southwest, 3 or 4 in the south but 4 or 5 occasionally 6 in the north.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, occasional rain in north and west later.

Mainly good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 6 in the south of the area, 6 to 7 with gusts to 45kt in the north.

Moderate to rather rough in the south, rather rough to rough in the north.

Scattered wintry showers dying out occasional rain or sleet later tonight, becoming persistent at times in the morning.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 6 to 7 with gusts to 45kt decreasing 5 to 6 in the evening then 4 to 5 by dawn, backing northerly 3 to 4 Saturday morning.

Rather rough to rough becoming slight to moderate.

Rain or sleet dying out later on Friday.

Moderate to poor in rain or sleet, becoming good.

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
