#### General Situation

Areas of low pressure over and around the United Kingdom will bring very unsettled conditions during the next couple of days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly northerly or northeasterly, veering easterly later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time in north, becoming variable 3 later.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair, occasional rain later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.

Slight or moderate.

Fair, showers later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in south, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.

Moderate.

Mainly fair, occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Moderate, becoming slight.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.

Moderate.

Rain or thundery showers, mainly in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly, backing northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, becoming slight.

Rain or thundery showers, becoming mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, backing northerly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough in far east.

Rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly, backing northwesterly, then southwesterly later, 4 or 5.

Rough at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Rain or thundery showers, fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 around headlands in east, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming northwesterly 3 or 4, backing southwesterly later.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or thundery showers, then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, backing northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, but moderate in west.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly, backing westerly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time in west.

Smooth or slight, but mainly moderate in far west.

Rain or showers, then mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, backing northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight in east, moderate in west.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly, backing westerly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time in west.  
Smooth or slight in east, moderate in west.  
Rain or showers, becoming mainly fair.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, becoming northwest, 4 or 5, backing southwest later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 or 5.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East, veering west or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair, then occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast veering south or southwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 for a time.  
Slight or mod.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around headlands.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast, veering west later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest at first.  
Occasional rain.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times in shelter.  
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly east or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable later.

Smooth or slight.

East or northeast 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times in shelter.

Slight or moderate.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly, veering easterly later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.

Slight or moderate.

Showers in south, otherwise mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly, becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 05 Jun 2011 at 0000 UTC until Sunday 05 Jun 2011 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure covers Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

North or northwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 2 or 3.

Moderate but slight in sheltered eastern waters.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Sunday 05 Jun until 0000 UTC on Monday 06 Jun:

Variable becoming mainly east or northeast later, 2 or 3.

Moderate in west at first, otherwise slight.

Fair.

Good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to north 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in the morning, backing north to northwest in the evening.

Slight to moderate.

Some morning mist patches a risk of thundery showers especially later.

Good, locally moderate to poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North to northwest 3 to 4.

Slight.

A risk of showers at first.

Mainly good.

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
