Forecast for Monday 06 May 2024

Weather: A lot of cloud through the day, this thick enough to bring some showery rain at times. Showers are likely to turn heavy with a chance of thunder later in the afternoon and early evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 30%, best chance towards evening

Low cloud and visibility: Poor in areas of low cloud down to 200 to 500 metres at first. Otherwise areas of cloud down to 750 metres throughout the day shrouding some of the summits at times. Cloud will become less extensive from mid-afternoon, more especially across western fells.

Forecast for Tuesday 07 May 2024

Weather: Cloudy in the morning with perhaps the odd light shower, but this clearing to allow some sunshine for the afternoon.

Maximum wind: Northerly 10 mph

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 30% in the morning, 60% in the afternoon

Low cloud and visibility: Poor in areas of low cloud down to 700 metres in the morning, this lifting off the tops in the afternoon with much improved visibility

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 8 rising to 17 Celsius

At 800m: Plus 10 Celsius

Freezing level: Above summits
