Weather: Mainly dry with clear spells overnight. Mainly dry and bright during daylight hours, but the odd shower is possible, these mostly likely over the Eastern and Far Eastern Fells, any showers wintry over the summits. Dry with skies often clear in the evening. Feeling chilly at height.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 80%

Visibility: Mostly very good, but moderate or poor in any showers and summit cloud. Any cloud mainly above the summits, but patches over the tops at times, mainly early in the day and in association with any showers.

Maximum wind: North or Northwest 15 to 20mph gusts 30mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 90%

Visibility: Mainly very good with no significant cloud expected.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Zero rising to plus 8 Celsius

At 800m: Zero to Plus 3 Celsius

Freezing level: Most levels early and late in the day, but around the summits in the afternoon.
