

Forecast for Sunday 10 Jul 2022

Meteorologist's View

The heat may make for arduous climbing, especially through the afternoon. Ensure you have plenty of water and protection from the sun to minimise the risk of dehydration, heat exhaustion and sunburn.

Forecast for Monday 11 Jul 2022

Weather: A very similar day to come on Monday, with the sunny and hot conditions continuing. The sunshine may become somewhat hazier at times through the day. High to very high UV levels again.

Maximum wind: Variable becoming mainly south, 5-10 mph, occasionally 15 mph later in the day.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 100%

Low cloud and visibility: No low cloud expected. Good visibility expected, although heat haze may limit clarity on distant hills.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 11 Celsius becoming plus 26 Celsius.

At 600m: Plus 16 Celsius becoming plus 19 Celsius

Freezing level: Well above the summits.
