Forecast for Monday 04 Jan 2021

Weather: Scattered snow showers during the early hours with associated low cloud. Dry and largely sunny through much of the day but turning increasingly cloudy later in the afternoon with snow showers pushing in from the northeast into the evening, these becoming more frequent into the overnight period.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 30% during the early hours. 90% for most of the day, 40% by evening.

Visibility: Generally good but moderate or poor in snow showers.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Feeling very cold, particularly at height.

Forecast for Tuesday 05 Jan 2021

Weather: Cloudy with scattered wintry showers throughout the day, some bright or sunny spells possible, particularly in the south.

Maximum wind: Northeasterly 20-25mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 40% throughout the day.

Visibility: Moderate or poor in snow showers, good otherwise.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 2 Celsius
At 800m: Minus 5 Celsius
Freezing level: 300m rising to 500m
