Forecast for Monday 05 Feb 2024

Weather: Similar to Sunday with overcast skies and occasional patchy light rain or drizzle, most persistent across western areas of the park.

Maximum wind: West or southwest 30mph with gusts reaching 50mph across most exposed ridges and summits.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m: 10% or less

Low cloud and visibility: Moderate or poor in rain and drizzle, very poor within cloud with bases extensive from 450m.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 9 Celsius increasing 13 Celsius during the afternoon

At 600m: Plus 5 Celsius

Freezing level: Above all summits
