Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Sunday 05 October to 0600 UTC Monday 06 October 2014

#### General Situation

A deepening frontal depression will move in from the Atlantic to give very windy and wet weather to the west of the British Isles later on Sunday, while a ridge of high pressure in the south moves away eastwards. During Monday, the very windy and wet weather will spread eastwards to all parts, with showery but calmer conditions following from the west later.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, backing south 6 or 7, then backing southeast 7 to severe gale 9 later.

Slight at first in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later.

Showers in northwest.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 or 6 in Moray Firth and far west. Moderate or rough in Moray Firth, otherwise rough or very rough.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 or 6, then backing southeast 7 or gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough later.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7 later.

Rough or very rough.

Rain at times.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4, backing south 5 or 6, then backing southeast 6 or 7 later.

Slight becoming moderate, then rough later.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 6 to gale 8, veering southwest 4 or 5 later.

Rough, becoming moderate later.

Rain at times, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, backing south 4 or 5, then backing southeast 5 to 7 later.

Slight, becoming moderate later.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 6 to gale 8, veering southwest 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate, becoming rough for a time.  
Fair at first then rain, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming southeasterly 5 or 6 later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 6 to gale 8, veering southwesterly 5 or 6 later.  
Moderate, becoming rough for a time in north.  
Fair at first, then rain, showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming southeasterly 5 or 6 later.  
Slight, becoming moderate later.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 6 to gale 8, veering southwesterly 5 to 7 later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Fair at first, then rain, thundery showers later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming south 4 or 5, then increasing 6 to gale 8 later.  
Slight, becoming moderate or rough later.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 6 to gale 8, veering southwest 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough.  
Rain at first, thundery showers later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming south 5 or 6, then increasing 7 to severe gale 9 later.  
Slight at first in east, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming very rough later in west.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 7 to severe gale 9, veering southwest 5 to 7.  
Very rough, becoming moderate or rough.  
Rain at first, then thundery showers.  
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming south or southeast 5 or 6, then increasing 7 to severe gale 9 later.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough later.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9, veering westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7.  
Very rough at first in west, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Rain at first, then thundery showers.  
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 6 to gale 8, then backing southeast gale 8 to storm 10 later.  
Moderate becoming rough, then very rough later.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeast gale 8 to storm 10, veering west or southwest 5 or 6.  
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate.  
Rain at first, then thundery showers.  
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 to 7, then backing southeast 7 to severe gale 9 later.  
Slight becoming moderate, then rough or very rough later.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, veering southwest 4 or 5, then becoming cyclonic later.  
Rough or very rough, becoming slight or moderate.  
Rain at first, thundery showers later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 6 or 7, then backing southeast gale 8 to storm 10 later.  
Slight, becoming moderate or rough, then very rough later.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeast gale 8 to storm 10, veering south or southwest 4 or 5.  
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate, then slight later.  
Rain at first, then showers.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest 5 or 6, backing south 6 to gale 8, then backing southeast gale 8 to storm 10 later.  
Moderate becoming rough, then very rough later in east.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, veering southwest 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3

or 4 later.  
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate.  
Rain at first, thundery showers later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, backing southerly 6 to gale 8, then backing southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9 later, occasionally storm 10 later in North Channel.  
Moderate becoming rough, then very rough later in North Channel.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, veering southwest 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate.  
Rain at first, thundery showers later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, backing south 7 to severe gale 9, then backing southeast gale 8 to storm 10 later.  
Moderate at first in shelter, otherwise rough or very rough, occasionally high later in northwest.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast gale 8 to storm 10, veering south 4 or 5, then becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Very rough at first in west, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Rain at first, showers later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, backing south 7 to severe gale 9, then backing southeast gale 8 to storm 10 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in south.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast gale 8 to storm 10, veering south 5 or 6, then backing east 4 or 5 later.  
Rough or very rough, becoming slight or moderate.  
Rain at first, showers later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, backing south 7 to severe gale 9, then backing southeast gale 8 to storm 10 later.  
Rough or very rough, occasionally high later in west.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast gale 8 to storm 10, veering south 5 or 6, then backing east 4 or 5 later.  
Very rough or high, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain at first, showers later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Sunday 05 Oct 2014 at 0600 UTC until Sunday 05 Oct 2014 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Icelandic low becomes complex and extends trough over Shetland Waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: southeasterly gale force 8  
expected later

South 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 05 Oct until 0600 UTC on Monday 06  
Oct:

South 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 later.  
Rough, but very rough in west.  
Occasional rain.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest or variable 1 to 3, becoming south to southeast 3 to 4 this afternoon,  
increasing 5 to 6 by midnight and 6 to gale 8 by dawn.  
Slight increasing rather rough to rough overnight.  
Risk of a shower this morning rain by dawn on Monday.  
Good, becoming moderate overnight, locally poor in rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southeast 6 to gale 8, veering west 4 around midday, backing southwest  
by evening, locally 5 with gusts to 35kt.  
Rather rough to rough, decreasing moderate by early afternoon, with a moderate  
swell.  
Rain, perhaps locally heavy, clearing around midday scattered showers  
developing by evening, locally heavy with a risk of thunder.  
Moderate to poor, becoming good by afternoon, locally moderate to poor in  
showers.

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
