Forecast for Friday 09 Dec 2022

Weather: Another dry day with some long clear or sunny spells.

Maximum wind: Mainly westerly or northwesterly 10mph or less.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m: Close to 100%

Low cloud and visibility: Little or no cloud expected below the summits with very good or excellent visibility.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Minus 5 or 6 Celsius at dawn rising to plus 1 or 2 Celsius by day

At 600m: Around minus 4 Celsius, rising briefly to minus 1 Celsius

Freezing level: Frozen surfaces persisting all day away from low levels.
