Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Monday 04 November to 1200 UTC Tuesday 05 November 2019

General Situation

An area of low pressure currently centred to the south of Ireland will move southeastwards to lie across northern France by Tuesday morning. This low will bring unsettled weather to all waters, with gales in some areas. A col will then develop across the United Kingdom for a time later on Tuesday and early on Wednesday, bringing a brief quieter interlude.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7, backing north 4 to 6 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in southeast.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 to 6 becoming variable 2 to 4.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers, wintry later.

Mainly good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, then backing north 4 to 6 later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate at first in south.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 to 6 backing northwest 3 to 5, then becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Rough, becoming moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 to 5 increasing 6 to gale 8, then decreasing 5 again later in north.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.

Showers then rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 5 to 7 backing north or northwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate later.

Rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 or less becoming northeasterly 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7 later, occasionally gale 8 later in north.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 6 to gale 8 backing north 4 or 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming moderate later.
Rain then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 or less becoming northerly or northwesterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 to 6, increasing 7 for a time, then backing northwesterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time in north.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 to 5 becoming cyclonic 5 to 7, then northwesterly 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, thundery at times.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 4 to 6, decreasing 2 or 3 for a time at first, then becoming north 4 to 6 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 to 6, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Moderate, becoming slight or moderate, then smooth or slight later.

Showers at first.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 to 5 at first in east, otherwise westerly veering northwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.

Rough or very rough west of the Lizard, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers, occasionally thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest mainly 4 to 6, but 7 at first near the Isles of Scilly, then backing west or northwest 2 to 4.

Rough or very rough at first in far west, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first in far west.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 2 to 4 at first except near Cornwall, otherwise northwesterly veering northerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in far west.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far west.

Showers, occasionally thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 to 7 decreasing 3 or 4, then becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in far west, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 to 5 backing north 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time later.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Showers, thundery at times.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4, then becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate, then smooth or slight later.

Showers, then rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast backing north or northeast, 4 to 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 4 to 6 veering east or northeast 2 to 4, then southeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time, then backing north 4 to 6 later.

Moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.

Rain or showers, becoming mainly fair later.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 4 to 6 becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 3 or 4 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time in east, then backing northerly 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or showers, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 to 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 3 to 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5 increasing 6 to gale 8, then decreasing 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time in North Channel.

Rain or showers, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 to 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then easterly or southeasterly 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first, then backing north 4 to 6.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter.

Showers, becoming fair later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 to 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then east or southeast 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 4 at times later.

Moderate or rough in north, slight or moderate in south.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 4 or 5 veering east 3 or 4, occasionally 5 again later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight except in far north.

Showers.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 4 at times later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 4 or 5 veering east 3 or 4, occasionally 5 again later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low across south UK slowly sinks southeast, maintaining a brisk northeasterly flow across Shetland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Northeast 5 to 7

Rough, occasionally moderate

Fair

Good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 05 Nov until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 05 Nov:

North or northeast 5 or 6

Moderate or rough

Showers

Good, occasionally moderate

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, becoming cyclonic variable after midnight, mainly in the east of the area, becoming northerly or northeasterly 6 or 7 in the west, perhaps gale 8, becoming northerly 5 or 6 by midday.

Rather rough to rough, becoming rough to very rough this afternoon, becoming moderate to rather rough overnight, locally rough in the west in the morning.

Occasional showers, heavy with the risk of hail and thunder, becoming more frequent and slow moving for a time overnight, then showers becoming isolated by midday.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in the afternoon, decreasing 4 or 5 around midnight and 2 to 4 by morning, backing west or southwest by midday.

Moderate to rather rough, occasionally rough in the afternoon mainly in the west, decreasing slight or moderate by morning, with a decreasing swell.

Isolated showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

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
