Forecast for Thursday 10 Nov 2022

Weather: Mainly cloudy with rather extensive hill fog and outbreaks of rain or drizzle, this most persistent across western hills, but some brighter interludes in the east.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 30%

Low Cloud and visibility: Mostly good visibility beneath cloud, but moderate or poor in rain and very poor in rather extensive cloud above 500m, though down to 400m at times in west.

Meteorologist's View

Mild and temperatures could reach 16 Celsius in the dales in any brighter spells, but windy with gusty increases also likely over leeward slopes, bringing some buffeting.

Forecast for Friday 11 Nov 2022

Weather: Very mild, but a windy and rather dull day with patchy rain and drizzle and areas of low cloud and hill fog, but perhaps some breaks in cloud and brighter spells in east.

Maximum wind: Southwest 30-35 gusts 45mph, but 40 gusts 55mph over higher summits

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 30%

Low Cloud and visibility: Very poor in mostly extensive cloud down to 500m, sometimes 400m, but more broken at times in east and mostly moderate to good visibility beneath cloud.

Temperature: **Valleys:** 13 or 14 C, but 18 C is possible in any breaks in cloud.

At 600m: 10 C

Freezing level: Well above summits
