Forecast for Sunday 03 Jul 2022

Weather: Cloud will build in from the west during the morning bringing some spells of rain at first though this will soon break to scattered showers into the late morning. Drier into the afternoon and evening with sunny spells.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 20% chance at first, rising above 80% by the afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Low cloud around 300-400m to start the day, mainly in the west, with visibility also turning moderate to poor in associated rain. The cloud will lift to above the summits for the afternoon. Visibility still reducing in any showers but remaining good to very good in between and turning so more widely once showers have eased.

Meteorologist's View

A poorer start to the day with moderate to poor visibilities and slippery paths due to rain during the early hours, feeling cool in the breeze. Conditions improving into the late morning, and more widely improving by the afternoon, and with sunnier skies so adequate sun protection is recommended.

Forecast for Monday 04 Jul 2022

Weather: A generally dry day with variable amounts of cloud and sunny spells, though there is a risk of an isolated light shower, mainly during the morning.

Maximum wind: Westerly to northwesterly 10 mph gusting 15-20 mph at the summits

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 40% initially, quickly rising to above 80%.

Low cloud and visibility: A chance of some patchy cloud around 500m at first, with some mist in the valleys. Cloud base generally above the summits for the remainder of the day.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 7 Celsius, rising to plus 11 Celsius.
At 600m: Plus 10 Celsius, rising to plus 18 Celsius
Freezing level: Above the summits
