Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Sunday 04 October to 1200 UTC Monday 05 October 2020

General Situation

A deep and complex low currently centred over England will drift slowly northeastwards into the North Sea through Monday and into Tuesday. This will bring unsettled conditions with gales at times, severe in southern areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain then showers, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly, becoming cyclonic later in south, 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later near Orkney.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later near Orkney.

Fair then showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 to 5, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6 for a time in south.

Rough becoming moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast, backing west or northwest later, 3 to 5.

Moderate, occasionally slight in south.

Showers, perhaps thundery in north.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Rough at first in north, otherwise moderate, becoming slight at times later in south.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming west 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic, becoming mainly northwest later, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 to 5, backing west or southwest 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in south and east, veering westerly or southwesterly 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough until later in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in south.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, increasing severe gale 9 at times, veering westerly 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough becoming rough or very rough, then slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, veering west or northwest 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough becoming rough or very rough, then slight or moderate later.

Rain or thundery showers, fair for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 to 7, perhaps increasing gale 8 at times.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, decreasing 4 or 5 for a time except in far southwest.

Very rough throughout west of Penzance, occasionally high at first southwest of the Isles of Scilly, otherwise moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.
Rough or very rough near the Isles of Scilly, otherwise moderate or rough.
Rain then showers.
Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West or northwest 7 to severe gale 9, veering northwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough north of lundy.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest backing west, 5 to 7, perhaps increasing gale 8 at times.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in south.
Rain then showers.
Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly gale 8 at first in far south, otherwise northerly or northeasterly, backing northwesterly, 4 to 6.
Moderate or rough in south, occasionally very rough at first in far south, slight or moderate in north.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest backing west, 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.
Moderate or rough in south, slight or moderate in north.
Occasional rain then showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Northeast backing north, then northwest later, 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwesterly 4 or 5, backing westerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 for a time in south.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast, backing north or northwest, then west or southwest later, 4 or 5.
Mainly slight.
Showers later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or northwest 4 to 6.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Northeast backing northwest, 3 to 5.

Rough or very rough west of Rathlin Island, otherwise slight, occasionally moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in far northwest.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest backing west, 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in far northwest.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in north.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly, backing northerly or northwesterly, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate near the Mull of Kintyre, otherwise smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 3 or 4, backing westerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 for a time.

Moderate near the Mull of Kintyre, otherwise smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in far northwest, decreasing 3 later.

Slight or moderate in sheltered east, otherwise moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers, becoming mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.

Mainly fair, then rain or showers, mainly in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Rain or drizzle, becoming mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast becoming variable, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair, showers later in north.

Good, occasionally moderate later in north.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming moderate later.
Rain or drizzle, becoming mainly fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast becoming variable, 2 to 4.
Moderate, occasionally slight later.
Mainly fair, showers later in north.
Good, occasionally moderate later in north.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Sunday 04 Oct 2020 at 1200 UTC until Monday 05 Oct 2020 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Large slow moving filling low, centered over the central UK, maintains an easterly flow.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in south
Moderate, occasionally rough at first, but slight at first in lee shelter near west coast of Shetland
Rain or showers
Moderate or good, occasionally poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 05 Oct until 1200 UTC on Monday 05 Oct:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south
Mainly moderate
Rain at first in west, otherwise mainly fair
Good, occasionally moderate or poor at first in west

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 6 to gale 8, veering northwesterly 4 to 6 locally 7 for a time overnight.
Rather rough to rough, occasionally very rough in the north and west of the area.
Showers then rain, occasionally heavy.
Moderate to good, locally poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 6 to gale 8, backing southwesterly 4 to 6 locally 7 for a time overnight.
Rather rough to rough, occasionally very rough in the west of the area at first.
Rain clearing to showers, some heavy.
Moderate to good, perhaps locally poor at times.

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
