General Situation

Strong southerly or southwesterly winds will affect many areas of the United Kingdom during the next few days. It will be unsettled too, particularly in the north and parts of the west.

South or southwest 5 to 7.
Very rough or high becoming rough, occasionally moderate in east.
Showers.
Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 04 Apr until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 05
Apr:

South or southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.
Moderate or rough.
Showers or longer spells of rain.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 3 to 4 backing southwest this morning increasing 4 to 5 in the north of the area, locally variable 1 to 3 in the south this afternoon, further backing southerly overnight generally 4 to 5, occasionally 6 mid-channel later

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Slight becoming moderate in the north, locally rather rough mid-channel later

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Fair becoming cloudy later

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Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southwest 4 to 5, locally 6 mid-channel, decreasing 3 to 4 later in the afternoon then 2 or 3 overnight

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Slight to moderate, locally rather rough in the north, becoming generally slight later
