Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

#### General Situation

Fronts will track southeast with a showery airflow following across the north. A wave will develop across the southwest and will track northeast tomorrow.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southwest or west 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good.

Moderate, but rough or very rough in north.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7.

Occasional rain.

Good.

Slight or moderate.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Occasional rain then fair.

Good.

Slight or moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5 backing south later.

Fair then rain.

Good.

Slight or moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5, backing south.

Fair then rain.

Good.

Smooth or slight.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4 increasing 5 or 6 later.

Fair then rain.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4 increasing 5 or 6 later.

Fair then rain.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4 increasing southwest 6 or 7 later.

Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate, but rough in west later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Westerly 4 or 5 backing south or southwest, increasing 5 to 7 later.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate, but rough in west later.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
West or southwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7 later.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate, but rough in west later.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest or west 4 or 5 increasing 5 or 6 later.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest or west 4 or 5 increasing 5 or 6 later.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest or west 5 or 6 backing southerly 5 to 7 later.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
West or southwest 5 to 7.  
Rain then showers.  
Moderate or good.  
Moderate or rough.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest or west 6 or 7.  
Rain then showers.  
Moderate or good.  
Moderate or rough.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides  
24 hour forecast:  
West or southwest 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8.  
Rain then showers.  
Moderate or good.  
Moderate or rough, but very rough in far west.

Shetland Isles  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly 6 to gale 8 veering west or southwest 5 to 7.

Rain then showers.  
Moderate or good.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough.

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
