Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Saturday 02 Jun until 0000 UTC on Sunday 03 Jun:

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 2 to 4, becoming variable 1 to 3 around dawn then northeast to east 2 to 4 by Sunday evening.

Smooth or slight.

Risk of mist patches until mid morning risk of a shower late Sunday evening.

Good, perhaps locally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to east 2 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 during the morning.

Smooth or slight occasionally moderate, with a low swell.

Risk of mist patches isolated showers, dying out by evening.

Good, perhaps locally moderate to poor.

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
