

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Friday 06 Mar 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Many places starting dry and sunny, but outbreaks of rain will soon reach Northern Ireland. The rain will spread east across Scotland, Wales and western England, perhaps preceded by snow across Scotland, then across remaining places overnight while becoming extremely light and patchy. Drier but cloudy conditions will follow to Northern Ireland later today, and to remaining western areas overnight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday starting dry and cloudy in many places, but outbreaks of rain will spread east, although not reaching southeast England until late afternoon. Saturday night heavy rain and strong winds quickly spreading east, leaving sunshine and wintry showers for Sunday.
