#### General Situation

Weak weather fronts will gradually clear southeast England overnight and on Tuesday. Otherwise pressure will gradually build across all areas with a large area of high pressure becoming centred over southern Scandinavia.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Cape Wrath, becoming variable 3 or 4 at times in Moray Firth.

Slight in east, moderate or rough in north.

Occasional drizzle in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times in Moray Firth.

Slight in east, moderate in north.

Occasional drizzle in north.

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.

Slight, occasionally moderate in far south.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southwesterly, veering northerly or northeasterly, 3 or 4, then veering easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Occasional rain or showers, becoming mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate in east.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

Variable, becoming mainly east or northeast, 3 or 4.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Deep low will be slow moving north of Iceland and extend troughs towards Shetland. Meanwhile, high pressure builds over the UK and then moves east towards the Baltic.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 in southeast.

Moderate or rough, but very rough in northwest at first.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Tuesday 02 Sep until 0000 UTC on Wednesday 03 Sep:  
Southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 in southeast, backing southerly later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Channel Islands

Slight.
