Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It'll be fine and sunny for many after a cold start. Despite this, showers, locally wintry, will become more widespread through the day. There will be the risk of rain and sleet across Northern Ireland and parts of southwest England later. Tonight will be mostly dry with some snow to Scotland and there'll be a widespread frost with icy patches.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday will be fine and sunny for many after a bitterly cold start. Wintry showers will affect some eastern coastal areas, possibly giving temporary accumulations here, with organised bands of snow easing elsewhere and it will be feeling cold outside.
