Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0000 UTC Monday 05 November to 0000 UTC Tuesday 06 November 2012

#### General Situation

An area of low pressure across southwest England will move away southeastwards allowing a ridge of high pressure to move in from the west, although Atlantic fronts will affect northern areas at times.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4, becoming northwest 4 or 5, backing southwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough north and west of Orkney.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Northwest, backing west later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7.

Slight near shore, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers, then rain.

Moderate or good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northeast backing northwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 or 6.

Slight near shore, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers, then occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast backing northwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 or 6 for a time later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 or 6.

Slight near shore, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers, then occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 or 6 for a time later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain then showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, then occasional rain.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming north or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 for a time, backing northwest 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Thundery showers, fair later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, then fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming northeast 5 or 6, backing northwest 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Thundery showers, fair later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 3 or 4 increasing 5 or 6, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly becoming cyclonic then northeasterly, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in far west, but mainly 4 or 5 in east at first, backing northerly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North backing northwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, then fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic becoming northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in west, but mainly 4 or 5 in far east, and backing northerly 4 or 5 later.

Slight in east, moderate or rough in west.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwesterly, 4 or 5 in east, 5 or 6 in west.  
Slight in east, moderate in west.  
Occasional showers, then fair.  
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeasterly 5 to 7 backing northerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near western headlands.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
North backing northwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 or 6 for a time.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Showers, then occasional rain.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeast backing northwest 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.  
Showers, then occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeast backing northwest 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 or 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeast backing northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in North Channel later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in north.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeast backing northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in North Channel later.  
Slight or moderate.

Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeast 2 or 3, occasionally 4, backing northwest 4 or 5.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Showers, occasional rain later.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7, backing southwest later.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
North 2 or 3, occasionally 4 backing west or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 or 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers then occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest, backing southwest later, 5 to 7.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.  
Rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
North 2 or 3, occasionally 4 backing west or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 or 6 later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Showers then occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or northwest, backing southwest later, 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.  
Rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Monday 05 Nov 2012 at 0000 UTC until Monday 05 Nov 2012 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
A ridge will move southeast over Shetland, before a trough swings in from the northwest later.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

North or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Moderate or rough.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 05 Nov until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 06 Nov:

North or northwest 4 or 5 backing southwest 5 or 6.  
Moderate, occasionally rough at first.  
Showers then rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest to west 5, locally 6 at first, very soon veering west to northwest, decreasing 3 or 4 by morning, further decreasing 1 to 3 in the north then veering northeast early afternoon and increasing 4 to 6, backing north 4 by midnight.

Rather rough, locally rough at first, becoming moderate in the morning.

Scattered rain or hail showers, locally with thunder, dying out in the evening.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 midnight, backing northwest in the afternoon and west overnight.

Moderate with a swell.

Fair.

Good.

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
