



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment
 Following steady rainfall on Thursday night and Friday, a spell of heavier rain is likely to bring some localised flooding during Saturday. Rainfall totals will be around 30-50 mm quite widely with 80 mm in a few more mountainous spots.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **00:00 on Sat, 31st Dec 2016** until **18:00 on Sat, 31st Dec 2016**

Outbreaks of rain will turn heavier across Northwest Scotland on Friday night and last well into Saturday (Hogmanay). Standing water and spray in combination with strong to gale force winds will bring difficult driving conditions, while localised flooding may lead to some low level travel disruption. The rain will gradually clear south during the afternoon.
