Weather: Some mist and fog to start, otherwise another dry with plenty of warm sunshine and light winds.

Maximum wind: Southeasterly 10-15 mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: Greater than 95%

Low cloud and visibility: Some mist and fog across valleys to start, otherwise any fair weather cloud above summits with excellent visibility.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 13 Celsius rising to plus 21 Celsius.
At 600m: Plus 10 Celsius rising to plus 15 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above summits.
